5) INDIA TAEKWONDO UID & IT BELT:-

- It is mandatory for all the participants to have India Taekwondo UID.
- It is mandatory for all the participants to have India Taekwondo Belt.

6) QUALIFICATIONS OF CONTESTANT:-

- An athlete must be 17 years old or older in the year 2024. Athletes who were born in the year of 2007 or before are eligible for participation in the competition.
- India Taekwondo black belt athletes in senior category who are Citizen of India.

7) REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEE:-

- Entry Registration: The event registration will be done through India Taekwondo Website.

Kyorugi Entry Fee:

- Rupees 2500/- per individual in regular registration period.

Poomsae Entry Fee:

- Rupees 2500/- per individual in regular registration.
- Rupees 3500/- per pair in regular registration.
- Rupees 4500/- per team in regular registration.

No Entry will be entertained after the last date i.e. 15th March 2024, 2:00 PM.

| <p>Two (2) Poomsae from designated Compulsory Poomsae decided by Poomsae Committee of selection for each division must be performed for all National Champion of Champions.</p> <p>Cut-off system:</p> <p>1) Preliminaries: In case 20 or more contestants / pairs / teams are participating, the National Champion of Champions shall start from preliminary round with division of groups at different courts. After performing two (2) assigned Compulsory Poomsae, the top half of each group shall advance to semi-final based on the points.</p> <p>2) Semi-final: In case nine (9) to 19 contestants / pairs / teams are participating, National Champion of Champions shall start from semi-final. Contestants shall perform two (2) assigned Compulsory Poomsae and top eight (8) of them shall advance to final based on the points.</p> <p>Single Elimination System:</p> <p>3) Final: When eight (8) or less contestants / pairs / teams are participating, National Champion of Champions shall start from final round. Final shall be conducted in a single elimination format. Contestants shall perform two assigned Compulsory Poomsae.</p> | <p>1) Free Style Poomsae is the performance based on taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.</p> <p>2) Composition of Free Style Poomsae</p> <p>2.1. eon-mu line shall choice of contestant</p> <p>2.2. Performed techniques must be within boundary of taekwondo. The definition of taekwondo techniques shall be determined by WT Poomsae Committee, when contestant submits performance plan of free style poomsae.</p> <p>Note: Music in USB (Music without lyrics) and choreography shall be choice of a contestant, it should NOT contain any political, social, and religious and any contents that may harm, discriminate or offend other.</p> |

12) REFEREES:-

- The Champion of Champions will be judged by the IT Kyorugi & Poomsae Referees (International & National Referee).

13) PROTEST IF ANY:-

- In case, there is Objection towards a Judgment, the concerned Coach / Manager/team leader must submit the Protest Application Form together with Prescribed Fee of Rs.5000.00 (Five thousand) which will be Non- refundable, the deliberations will be done/settled as per WT rules by the Jury of appeal/Board of Arbitration/CSB within ten minutes after the pertinent contest.
- Once deliberation will be done, discipline have to be maintained, otherwise disciplinary committee will be taking appropriate action against any indiscipline (as per WT sanctions rules).

14) RANDOM WEIGH IN:-

- Weigh-In: As per Rules and regulations of World Taekwondo (WT) weigh-in shall be completed on the previous day of the relevant contest, according to the Champion of Champions schedule. Weigh-in shall be made once, however, one more weigh-in is granted within time limit to the athlete who did not qualify the first time. Absentees will be disqualified.
- Random weigh-in: The randomly selected athletes must be present for random weigh in before the start the Champion of Champions, Government card (Birth Certificate, Aadhar Card, and Passport) should be produced at the time of random Weigh-in. It is also requested that weight of every player must be accurate which will be sent in online entry form during registration and weigh-in otherwise players will disqualify. No request of weight consideration will be accepted at any condition.

15) PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT & UNIFORM:-

- The participants shall wear the WT recognized Taekwondo Uniform. The **KPNP PSS** will be used at this Tournament and will be provided by the OC (Organizing committee).
- All athletes must bring their own **KPNP sensor socks**.
- Groin/Forearm/shin guards and Gloves are compulsory & must be brought by the contestants.
- Mouth Piece is compulsory (Only white or transparent will be allowed).
- Poomsae Champion of Champions uniform: All Participants may wear WT-approved Poomsae Champion of Champions uniform.

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- **Senior (Ages 17-50):** White top with dark blue pants for males; white top with light blue pants for females.

- **Master Division (Ages 51 and up):** Yellow top with dark blue pants for males and females.



NOTE:

- The schedule is subject to change depends upon the number of participants.
- Athletes must be in Dobok & sports shoes for the medal Ceremony
- Coaches must wear shoes and Tracksuit for all preliminary to semi-final matches in FOP. Blazer or Tracksuit & Shoes for FINAL matches are mandatory.
- **Only India Taekwondo level 3 Coaches are allowed in the Competition.**
- **Boarding & Lodging during the National Champion of Champions will not be provided by the organizers; participants have to make their own arrangements.**
- **Medal will not be given to Champion of Champions Stop.**
